

PRIVACY POLICY

COLLECTION AND PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

You can use and browse our website without disclosing your personal data, and are not required to provide personal data as a condition of using our website, except as may be necessary as part of our providing you with our services, to respond to your requests or in cases where you contact us directly.

We collect personal data only when you provide it to us, through emails, inquiries and requests, and similar situations in which you have chosen to provide the information to us.

SAFEGUARDING YOUR ACCESS

These security products include routers, firewalls, intrusion detection systems and secure operating system to safeguard your interest. We use Industry standard Secure Socket Layer (SSL) communication protocol as the cryptographic standard for securing data communication between the browser and the Oculus Private Limited Website.
